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Competition Guidelines

- The annual SCCTM art competition is open to K-12 students across the state, as long as their math teacher is a current member of SCCTM. If the teacher sponsor is a not member or needs to rejoin, please include payment along with the submission form.
- One piece of artwork may be selected for submission from each school from each grade band: K-2, 3-5, 6-8 and 9-12 with a maximum of four (4) pieces of art work submitted from an individual school.
- Each submission must be representative of this year's theme, **“Building Your Math Superpower – Taking Action!”**
- Each piece of artwork must have an SCCTM member, math teacher sponsor. It is permissible to join for the first time or rejoin when submitting the artwork.
- Each submission must have a thematic title and a label placed on the artwork including the student's first and last name, the name of the math teacher sponsor, grade, school, contact number/e-mail address, county or school district. The label should be on the back side of the artwork.
- **The deadline for all entries to arrive by mail or email is June 10, 2019.** When mailing entries, please allow at least a week before that date to ensure sufficient time for mail delivery. Entries postmarked or received after this date will not be eligible for judging. (Entries will be judged by the SCCTM board during the summer board meeting in Columbia.)



Eligible Types of Artwork

- Each submission must be the original work of an individual artist.
- Submissions may be on a regular sized sheet of white poster paper, 22 in x 28 in in size.
- Artwork may alternatively be submitted digitally in the form of a digital graphic design or as 3D digital illustrations. Digital results must be submitted as clear and readable, in color, in PDF format, and as an 8 in x10 in size.
- PDF submissions should be emailed in color as an 8 in x 10 in PDF format to Don Sarazan: vpelementary@scctmconference.org and must arrive by the contest deadline, including a copy of the submission form. Any membership payments for new or rejoining members, must arrive by the deadline via mail. Current members may email the filled in submission form with their membership number.

Judging

- Judging criteria is based solely on the content of the piece of art. Students nor teachers will be present during the judging.
- Judges will consider such factors as:
 - ❖ Is the artwork original and creative?
 - ❖ Does the theme relate to mathematics?
 - ❖ Does the art work relate to the theme and does it convey the theme well?
 - ❖ Is the presentation appealing and pleasing to the eye?
 - ❖ Is the overall design easy to follow?

Prizes

A First-place winner as well as an Honorable Mentions will be selected from the submissions within each grade band. Each first-place student winner will be recognized and awarded \$50.00 during the annual business awards ceremony meeting late Thursday afternoon, November 14, during the 2019 SCCTM Annual Conference at the Greenville Convention Center. The First-place sponsoring teachers will receive a complimentary one-year SCCTM membership extension, a \$25 meal gift card will be given to the teachers, as well as a \$25 meal gift card to the art teachers, the First-place winning math teachers worked with. After judging, the winning artwork will be displayed at the 2019 SCCTM Annual Conference at the Greenville Convention Center and after the conference at EdVenture Children's Museum in Columbia. The First-place and Honorable Mention winners will all be show-cased in the 2019 SCCTM Conference program book which may be accessed from the SCCTM.org website.

SCCTM aims to encourage creativity and art appreciation within children of all ages through a variety of mediums such as oils, pastels, crayons, markers, and technology while encouraging the expression of their own individuality, using art to explore and express mathematics.
